I want to make sure they get what they need.”

Loretta points out that each cat that gets adopted is saved by the family it goes home with. If it were not for groups such as hers, most of the kittens and cats they adopt out would either be put to sleep at a local animal shelter overrun by drop-offs and strays, or they would die on the streets. Her work to encourage spaying and neutering also helps control the cat population by making sure that each of the animals she adopts out can not add to the problem.

“I want to make sure that each kitten that is born reaches a wonderful and loving family,” Davis exclaims. “But to do that, we need to control the population as part of our adoption process.”

Funds used to provide these, and other veterinary services, are raised through her adoption events and the kind donations of supporters in our area.

“Loretta is the perfect example of someone in our community that has identified an issue that is dear to her heart and has taken action,” stated Marisa Matyola of WBOY-TV. “Holding the number of adoption events she does is a testament to the dedication she has to save as many kittens as she can, and I am honored to help recognize her efforts.”

With Spring fast approaching, so is kitten and puppy season. With many residents in the area ignoring the need to spay or neuter their pets, there is always a flux of abandoned litters. To help find animals in need good homes, organizations have been created throughout our region. One of those organizations that is directly focused on finding homes for kittens in need is The Davis Crew Kittens. Created and ran by Loretta Davis, the group holds adoption events throughout the month in conjunction with many other organizations, including The Exotic Jungle in Morgantown.

Before the kittens are adopted out, Loretta makes sure they have the treatments they need, including vaccinations and spay/neutering procedures. Once the kitten is ready for a family, Davis and her fellow volunteers gather them up from their foster homes to travel to local adoption events. Working with other organizations, Davis has adopted out hundreds of kittens over the past few years.

“Each kitten is special to us. We work hard to ensure that a loving family eventually adopts each one,” said Davis. “These cats need our help, and

Recipe of the Month: Spinach Quiche

Ingredients:

1/2 cup butter
3 cloves garlic, chopped
1 small onion, chopped
1 (10 oz) pck frozen chopped spinach, thawed and drained
1 (4.5 oz.) can mushrooms, drained
1 (6 oz.) herb and garlic feta, crumbled
1 (8 oz.) package shredded cheddar cheese
salt and pepper to taste
1 (9 in.) unbaked deep dish pie crust
4 eggs, beaten
1 cup milk

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.
2. In a medium skillet, melt butter over med. heat. Saute garlic and onion in butter until browned. Stir in spinach, mushrooms, feta and 1/2 cup cheddar cheese. Season with salt and pepper. Spoon mixture into pie crust.
3. In a medium bowl, whisk together eggs and milk. Season with salt and pepper. Pour into pastry shell, allowing egg mixture to thoroughly combine with spinach mixture.
4. Bake in preheated oven for 15 minutes. Sprinkle top with remaining cheddar cheese and bake and additional 35 to 40 minutes, until set in center. Allow to stand 10 minutes before serving.

March's Cases of Interest

Back Up in Traffic Leads to Distracted Driver Slamming into Car

Our client contacted us after being rear ended in a traffic jam that was caused by a construction site on Rt 19. As he was sitting in traffic waiting for his turn to move, he noticed a truck in his rear-view mirror flying towards him. He specifically remembers noticing the driver of the truck looking down at his cell phone and not paying attention to the stopped traffic in front of him until it was too late. Lucky for our client, a sheriff deputy was also stuck in that traffic.

The injuries sustained by our client include a rotator cuff tear and various scrapes and bruises. He also missed a number of days at work, which will only add to his claim.

Car Goes Airborne and Strikes a Car Driving in Other Lane

Our client was driving out towards West Union on a side street, when another driver was speeding in the opposite lane and suddenly lost control of their vehicle. With the amount of speed the vehicle had gained, it swerved towards our client and became airborne, slamming into the passenger side of their vehicle, injuring everyone in the car.

As a result of the crash, the accident victims received a number of injuries including a concussion, an injured jaw, injuries to the knee, abrasions on the neck and potentially diagnosed PTSD. Although each are treatable, the lasting impact of the accident and how it occurred will remain on the mind of everyone in the vehicle that day.

Round Up Leading to Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma

We have received a number of calls in reference to the nationally recognized tie between Round-Up and Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma. A recent court decision has confirmed a direct link between the extensive use of Round-Up and that specific type of cancer.

After weeks of testimony, a jury decided that there was a direct correlation and that the manufacturer of the commonly used weed killer knew about the dangers and did nothing to warn the public or to mitigate the damages. As a result, a multi-million dollar verdict was issued and a number of additional victims have begun to contact our office to discuss their options.

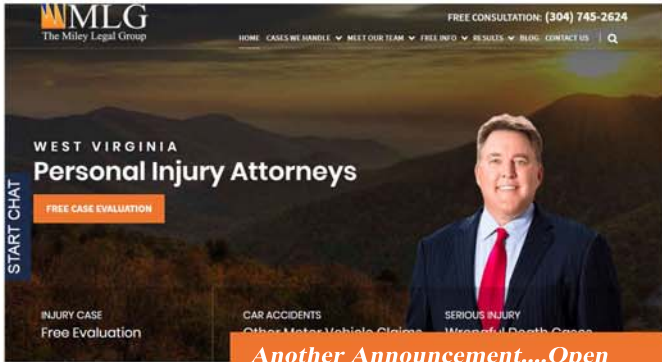
